Entry Fee: \$22 for first entry per dog per day; \$10 second entry fee per dog per day. (Includes \$3.00 AKC recording fee for first class; \$1 recording fee for second class). A maximum of 10 entries per envelope is allowed. Envelopes with more than 10 entries and/or entries received prior to the opening date will be returned.

Show Conditions: Standard indoors on agility matting; JWW outdoors on grass

Course familiarization: There will be no contact obstacle familiarization at this trial.

Electronic Timers will be used in these trials. **Obstacles will conform to current requirements of the AKC Agility Regulations.**

All dogs without official AKC Jump Height Cards must be measured prior to their first runs. See the complete rules and regulations for agility trials at www.akc.org.

Refunds: No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of nature, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other causes beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. Bitches in season will be awarded a refund (with Veterinary Certificate), less \$10 processing fee.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or have AKC Limited Registration, or are of a registerable breed that have obtained an AKC ILP number. Dogs eligible for entry in the Miscellaneous Class at dog shows are eligible to participate. Spayed bitches and neutered males are eligible. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, dogs that are blind or deaf or suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness that may affect their physical or mental performance, are not eligible to participate.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Proof of rabies vaccination should be available.

Liability: Exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Three Rivers Shetland Sheepdog Club and Youngstown All-Breed Training Club and their agents, employees, volunteers, etc., will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

Dogs will run small to large both days. In each jump height, B dogs will run first, followed by A dogs, followed by Preferred dogs when possible. Preferred 4” dogs will run first.

Prizes and Awards

Rosettes will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place qualifying dogs in each class and height division. Flat qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs with qualifying scores. MACH bars and MACH rosettes will be awarded to all MACH titles earned at this show. New title ribbons will be awarded to those earning a title at the trials.

Directions to Show Site

From South: Take I-77 or I-71 N toward Cleveland. Exit onto I-76 East toward Akron. Take I-80 toward Youngstown and NYC. Take 11 south. Exit on Route 46. Turn left (South) towards Columbiana. Turn right (west) at Route 14. Travel west on Route 14 for 4 miles. Turn left onto Painters Path, the graveled driveway to the show site. (Painters Path is immediately after Sky Bank.)

From West: Take I-80 East to 11 South. (Short detour, well marked from 80 to 11 at time of this printing.) Exit 11 at the Route 46 exit. Turn left (south) to Columbiana. Turn right onto Route 14. Travel west on Route 14 for 4 miles. Turn left onto Painters Path, the graveled driveway to the show site. (Painters Path is immediately after Sky Bank.)

Or take I-76 East to Route 14. Turn right onto 14 and proceed through Deerfield and Salem on 14. Show site will be on your right in Washingtonville, just before Sky Bank.

From East: Take I-76 west toward Ohio. Exit at Route 7 (second exit in Ohio). Go south (toward North Lima) on 7. Turn right at Route 164. Take 164 South to Route 14. Turn right onto 14. Travel west on Route 14 for 4 miles. Turn left onto Painters Path, the graveled driveway to the show site. (Painters Path is immediately after Sky Bank.)

From North: 11 South to Route 46 exit. (Short detour on 80 at time of this printing.) Turn left toward Columbiana. Turn right onto Route 14. Travel west on Route 14 for 4 miles. Turn left onto Painters Path, the graveled driveway to the show site. (Painters Path is immediately after Sky Bank.)

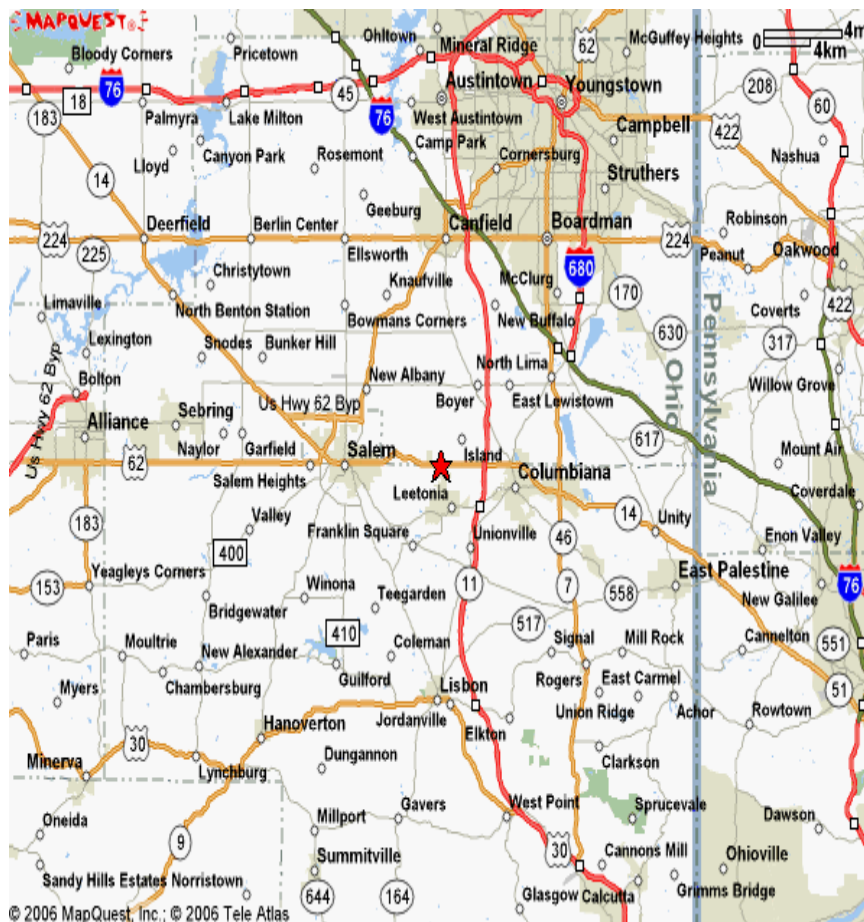

Four Seasons K-9 Athlete Center is a new facility (opened this year) with a large building and over 100 dog-friendly acres outdoors. While the indoor area is not air conditioned, there are overhead doors that provide cross breezes. There is indoor crating and plenty of room outdoors if you wish to set up there. The flooring is thick agility matting.

The outdoor ring is on grass planted last year. Straw or other material will be brought in if conditions warrant it.

Best of all, there are indoor flush toilets. Additional outdoor port-pots will be provided if the trial entry suggests that they are needed.

You are welcome to walk your dogs back into the site, but you are asked to avoid trampling on any crops growing. There are ponds at the back of the property where your dog can swim. Please avoid the pond at the front, near the house, because while the property was uninhabited, people dumped things in it.

You may bring a self-contained camper or stay in a tent. There are no camper hookups. The restrooms will be open from 6 a.m. until 10 p.m. Facility owners will advise you about where to set up.

As always, please pick up after your dogs. The entire site should be as clean or cleaner when we leave than when we arrived to encourage the owners to hold other agility events.

Food will be available on site. There are also restaurants in Salem (about 3 miles west) and Columbiana (four miles east).

Parking

You may pull up to the building to unload if you plan to crate indoors. Please allow the Four Seasons staff to direct you to parking appropriate for your vehicle.

Move Ups

Move ups will be accepted until 6 p.m. on October 2nd via mail or email. Move ups will also be accepted day-to-day according to AKC regulations.

Dogs entered in the *Preferred* classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division. All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial or *back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
