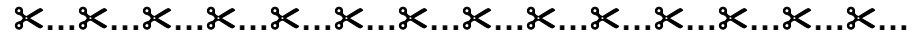

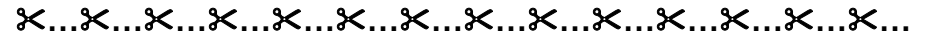

Camping: You may park your camper overnight Friday and Saturday at the Pittsburgh Indoor Sports Area. Parking is limited to only those spaces in the designated area behind the building. First come first served. NO RESERVATIONS, NO FEE. No hook ups are available for electricity or water, and no dumping station is available. Your camper will need to be self contained and have a working fire extinguisher. No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted inside or within 100 feet of any building, on the PISA grounds in which this dog show is conducted.

Directions to Trial Site

From Pittsburgh and South: Take Route 28 north to the Harmar exit. Turn left onto Route 910 *and proceed for approximately ¼ mile until you almost reach the crest of the hill. Turn right onto Rich Hill Rd. The facility is on the right after you cross the Turnpike.

From the Pennsylvania Turnpike: Leave the Turnpike at Exit 48 and follow signs to Pittsburgh. Travel approximately ½ mile until Route 910 leads off to the right. Turn right onto Route 910 and follow the directions from * above.

Height Divisions

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. Dogs without a valid height card will be measured by the judge of record, except those jumping 24", unless an AKC Rep or VMO is present, and then all dogs without a valid height card MUST be measured including those jumping 24".

Move Up Regulations

If a dog earns an agility title before this event, it can be advanced to the next level of competition. However, written notice MUST be given to Trial Secretary no later than 6 PM Monday June 9, 2008. Day to Day Move-ups will be accommodated at the trial. No verbal changes will be accepted.

Refunds

No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other causes beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. Bitches in season will be awarded a refund (with a Veterinary Certificate), less \$10 processing fee per day. No refunds will be given in the event that the air conditioning is not up and functioning by the date of our trial. Air conditioning is solely the responsibility of the Pittsburgh Indoor Sports Arena, and out of the control of the Three Rivers Sheltand Sheepdog Club of Greater Pittsburgh, Inc.

Liability

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Countryside Agility, TRSSCGP and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, & further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the AKC, or have AKC Limited Registration, or are of a registerable breed that have obtained an AKC ILP/PAL number. Dogs eligible for entry in the Miscellaneous Class at dog shows are eligible to participate. Spayed bitches and neutered males are eligible to participate. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, dogs that are blind or deaf or suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect its physical or mental performance, are not eligible to participate.

Food and Concessions

There will be a food vendor available on site.

Crating Space

There is plenty of crating available. Please bring plastic, mats or tarps to put under crates that are going to be sitting on the sports turf.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division.

Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running. If this entry is for Junior Showmanship, please give the following information:
