Telephone, fax and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Mail entries to: **Debbie Lundy, 12 Mitchell Drive, Pittsburgh, PA 15241.** Make all checks payable to: **TRSSCGP, INC.** Overnight entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the Show Secretary's address without recipient's signature. Otherwise, if no recipient is present to sign receipt, entries may be returned to sender.

Entries not on an Official AKC Entry Form or photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form will not be accepted. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. **Entries received without fees will not be accepted. Owners are solely responsible for errors in making out entries. No entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after published closing date. PLEASE PRINT OR TYPE.**

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused by the judge or veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the show-giving club, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund will be made.

Post Dated Checks and Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. Three Rivers Shetland Sheepdog Club of Greater Pittsburgh, Inc. will add a collection fee of \$25.00 to the amount of the returned check.

No refund for duplicate entries. We will make every effort to find duplicate entries, but if the entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Show grounds will be available Friday, January 30, for set up. Show grounds will be available at 7:00 a.m. on January 31. Dogs may arrive anytime prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in an exercise ring.

Judges are not required to wait for any dog holding up a class. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having the dog at ringside when its class is to be judged.

A qualifying score is required in all Regular Classes for Obedience Prizes. All prizes will be awarded in the ring when judging of that class is over. None will be mailed.

*****IMPORTANT NOTE*****

No chalking will be allowed in the grooming building. All exhibitors must have something under their crates in the building to protect the floor.

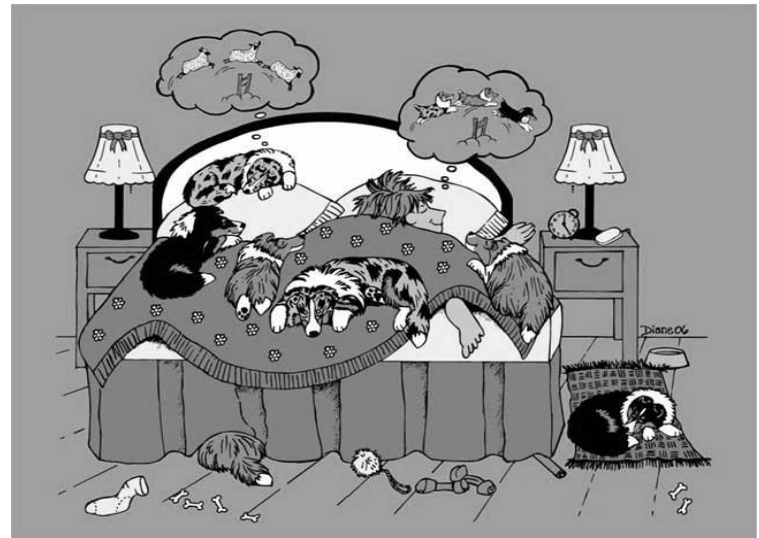

Effective 1 January 1992, Chap. 10, Sec. 13 of Dog Show Rules has been amended to allow judges to judge up to 200 dogs at Independent Specialties

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW LOCATION

**PLEASE READ CAREFULLY
MANY OF THE STREETS ARE UNMARKED SO LOOK FOR
THE "WASHINGTON COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS" OR
"WASHINGTON AGRICULTURAL FAIR" SIGNS.**

FROM I-70 East : Take Exit 17 (PA 18, Jefferson Ave). At the end of ramp, turn right on to PA 18 North. Follow PA 18 North for 1.3 miles. Turn right at the traffic light just past Jack's Muffler & Brake Shop. Follow road for 0.5 miles to stop sign. Bear left and continue 0.3 miles to Washington County Fairgrounds. Use entrance "C".

FROM I-70 West: Take Exit 17 (PA 18, Jefferson Ave). At end of ramp, turn right. Go 0.1 miles and turn right on to PA 18 North. Follow PA 18 North 1.1 miles. Turn right at traffic light. (No street sign, but just past Jack's Muffler & Brake shop on the right). Follow road for 0.5 miles to a stop sign. Bear left and continue 0.3 miles to the Washington County Fairgrounds (on North Main St.). Use Entrance "C".

FROM I-79: Take Exit 41 (Race Track Rd). Do NOT take exit 40. Look for the Washington County Fairgrounds or Washington Agricultural Fair signs at the end of the exit ramp. Go west (right turn from I-79 South, or left turn from I-79 North). Go 0.2 miles to a light and make a left turn on to Pike Street. Follow Pike Street for 0.7 miles to a light. Turn right at that light. Follow road for 1 mile to stop sign. Turn right at the stop sign. After 0.1 miles, the road will split - bear left on to North Main. Continue 0.9 miles to the Washington County Fairgrounds. Use entrance "C".

Brace Class Entry Fees: Entry fee is \$12.00 (each dog) for any dog NOT entered in another class, and \$5.00 for any dog which is entered in another class. For any dog which is to be part of a Brace and is not entered in another class, a separate entry form must be used, full particulars given, and the dog entered for "Brace Class Only." Dogs need not be registered to the same owner. Please indicate "Obedience Brace Class" on entry form.

Veterans class shall be for dogs that have an obedience title and are 7 or more years old on the date of the trial. The exercises shall be performed and judged as in novice. Dogs entered in the Veterans class may be entered in any regular class.

Bitches in Season: A refund of all but \$2.00 of the entry fee will be made to any exhibitor who has a bitch entered which comes in season after the entries close, providing a statement from a Veterinarian is presented to the Show Secretary no later than 12:00 P.M. the day of the show, after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, altered or substituted, except as provided for in Chapter 14, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules.

JR. SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

Novice Junior Class – For Boys and Girls at least 10 and under 14 years of age on the day of the show who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Intermediate Class - For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Senior Class – For Boys and Girls at least 14 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Junior Class – For Boys and Girls at least 10 and under 14 years of age on the day of the show who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Intermediate Class – For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Senior Class – For Boys and Girls at least 14 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

Each dog handled in a regular Junior Showmanship class must be entered and shown in one of the Breed or Obedience Classes at the show, or must be entered for Junior Showmanship only. Each dog must be owned or co-owned by the Junior Handler's father, mother, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, grandfather or grandmother, including step and half relations. Each dog entered for Junior Showmanship must be eligible to compete in dog shows or in Obedience Trials. A dog that has been excused or disqualified by a Breed Judge or by a Bench Show Committee may still be handled in Junior Showmanship if eligible to compete in Obedience Trials. A dog that has been rejected, dismissed or excused by a Veterinarian for the protection of the other dogs at the show or for the protection of the dog excused may not be handled in Junior Showmanship.

The winner of a third First Place in each Novice Class shall automatically become eligible to enter in the corresponding Open Class at this show, provided that there are one or more Junior Handlers competing in that Open Class.

Winning of First Place in the Open Junior Showmanship Class at the show may qualify or count towards qualification in certain future limited Junior Showmanship Classes. For information on eligibility requirements for limited Junior Showmanship classes which have been approved to date by the AKC, write to The American Kennel Club, 5580 Centerview Drive, Raleigh, NC 27606.

Effective January 1, 1999, Juniors will be recognized for participating in obedience, agility, earthdog, lure coursing and herding events. To record wins in these events, the Junior Handler is responsible for the completion of the Junior Handler Certification Form. These forms will be supplied to all Show Superintendents, Field Representatives and to each Club upon approval of their event.

The ownership requirements are the same as for participating in Junior Showmanship, the dog must be owned by the Junior Handler or the Junior Handler's father, mother, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, grandfather, or grandmother, including corresponding step and half relations, or by a member of the Junior Handler's Household. AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship.

They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically

articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.

SWEEPSTAKES

Open to all Shetland Sheepdogs who, on the day of the show, will be 6 months and under 18 months of age. All entries must also be entered in a Regular Conformation Class. No AKC Champion of Record may be shown. Entry fee is Free. Enter Sweepstakes on the same entry form as for Regular Classes by including "Sweepstakes" in the space for additional classes. The Sweepstakes will be judged prior to the Regular Classes.

The sexes will be divided in the following classes:

Puppy Dogs 6 months & under 9 months
Puppy Dogs 9 months & under 12 months
Junior Dogs 12 months & under 18 months
(Same Classes for Bitches)
Best in Sweepstakes
Runner-Up to Best in Sweepstakes
